

## - APPLYING TO UNIVERSITY -

(O.U.A.C. – “Ontario Universities’ Application Centre”)

- Your application to university is handled by OUAC. Once they issue you a PIN (late Nov./early Dec.), you apply online through their website.  
(Note: You are a “101 Applicant” if you are currently in highschool.)
- The application fee of \$150 allows you to apply to as many as 3 programs. Additional choices can be added at a cost of \$50 each.
- Universities base admission on the average of your best 6 Grade 12 “U” or “M” level courses, including any required pre-requisites. Be sure to check for any other requirements, such as supplemental applications.  
Mark “cutoffs” (from the previous group of applicants) are published and made available to you as a rough guide.
- Eden will electronically download your marks after each reporting cycle.
