(O.C.A.S. – “Ontario Colleges’ Application Service”)

- Your application to college is handled by OCAS, which utilizes the Ontario Colleges’ website to facilitate the process.
- The fee of \$95 covers your online application to as many as 5 programs, with no more than 3 program choices at any one college.
- Most college programs require only that you’ve graduated from highschool with either your Grade 12 “C” or “U” English, but be sure to check for any other pre-requisite courses and/or requirements.
Minimum mark “cutoffs” may apply to required courses, and over-subscribed/competitive programs may have much higher cutoffs.
- Eden will electronically download your marks after each reporting cycle.
